## GLOBAL PUBLIC CONFIDENCE STUDY 2024 Report on Health Care



### Introduction



- The 2024 IRIS Global Public Confidence Study provides a multi-country view of public sentiment across the most important issues of the day. The project aimed to understand:
  - 1. Public assessments of the economy and personal finances
  - 2. Levels of confidence and concern about climate change
  - 3. Perspectives on the state of healthcare systems
  - 4. Awareness, usage and attitudes towards artificial intelligence
- This report presents the health care results. Separate reports address views on economic confidence, climate and on artificial intelligence.
- More than **14,000 people were surveyed across 21 countries** (14,096).
- Fieldwork was completed during June, July, and August 2024 (with one country completed in February).
- A nationally representative sample of 500 to 1,000 adults was interviewed in each country.
- Data was collected online in 21 countries, by telephone (CATI) in Turkey.
- > Overall results are compared with 2023 results (18 countries are common with 2023 study).

## **1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**



#### **Executive Summary**


- Overall, views about health care systems lean to pessimistic, with a majority saying the system is either in crisis (24%) or deteriorating (34%). About four in ten think their country's system is in excellent (8%) or good shape (33%). More than half in Greece, and over four in ten in Nigeria, Kenya, Panama and Poland think their country's health care system is in a state of crisis.
- When asked about the cause of problems in health care systems, two-thirds blame inefficient management (60%) compared to insufficient funding (38%). Roughly three-quarters in Switzerland, Panama and South Korea blame inefficient management.
- On average, just under four in ten approve of the way their country's national government is handling the issue of health care. Approval levels vary considerably across countries. Approval levels are the highest in Malaysia (75%), South Korea (68%) and Indonesia (60%) and lowest in Nigeria (13%), Greece (19%), Turkey (21%), Kenya (23%) and Japan (23%).
- On average, almost four in ten are confident that the country does a good job of caring for the health of the more vulnerable in society. Confidence levels are the highest in Malaysia (71%) and Australia (59%) and lowest in Turkey (15%), Greece (17%) and Nigeria (20%).
- More than four in ten are confident that the country's health care services are among best in the world. Over eight in ten are confident about their health care services being best in the world in Spain, South Korea and Switzerland. Confidence levels are lowest in Greece (10%), Turkey (16%), Poland (18%) and Nigeria (20%).
- Half are confident that medical science and pharma will be able to solve most of the health issues that face their country today. Confidence levels are highest in Malaysia (72%), South Korea (68%) and Spain (65%) and lowest in Japan (29%) and Turkey (31%).





Q. Generally speaking, do you approve or disapprove of the way [country's] national government is handling the issue of health care?









Q. How confident are you that... [Country's] health care services are among the best in the world?










